School Buddies 2019-2020 School Year

School Buddies has officially kicked off for the 2019-2020 School Year. School Buddies is a mentoring program that meets once a week for 30 minutes during the school day. High school "big buddies" travel to the elementary schools to work with "little buddies" on activities relating to the Search Institute's 40 Developmental Assets. Topics include: positive identity, empowerment, social competencies, reading for pleasure, and commitment to learning. In the 2018-2019 school year we had over 250 matches in 8 school districts (Bellevue, Edison, Fremont, Hopewell-Loudon, Huron, Sandusky Central Catholic, Sandusky City, and Vermilion). We are excited to see what the 2019-2020 school year holds and can't wait to meet our matches!

Want to make an impact? Become a Mentor!

Being a mentor is simple! We ask that you meet with your mentee for a minimum of 3 to 4 hours a month, based around your schedule. We provide monthly activities for you and your mentee to attend, and occasionally we have tickets donated for special events.

Currently, there are **53** children in Erie County and **19** children in Sandusky County waiting for a mentor.
